## Academic Recognition:

- 1) Currently on academic scholarship in College (freshman, sophomore, junior or senior)
- 2) 2016 college applicants who graduated with honors (suma cum laude, magna cum laude, cum laude)
- 3) 2016 high school applicants who graduated with honors (Valedictorian, Salutatorian)

## Leadership Recognition:

- 1) 2016 President of Student Government Body (high school or college)
- 2) 2016 President of any Filipino American youth association/organization in colleges or universities
- 3) 2016 President of any Filipino American youth community organization/association (i.e. Leo's, Samahang Bayan, etc.)

Recognition of achievement in the following:

- 1) Music
- 2) Dance
- 3) Sports
- 4) Community volunteer service

Each application form must be accompanied with proof of achievement for the category being applied for, by submitting one or more of the following:

- 1) Copy of scholarship offer
- 2) Copy of official report card
- 3) Letter from school or organization

- 5) Letter of endorsement from responsible official of affiliated clubs or organizations
- 6) Clippings from either school newspaper or other newspapers
- 7) Other official supporting documents
